PE

Year 2 PE days are **Wednesday** and **Thursday**. Children should wear their PE kit to school on these days. Please ensure they have appropriate footwear (trainers or plimsolls) that they can run in.

Clothing

Please ensure your child has a warm waterproof coat during the colder months. In summer, your child will need a named sunhat. We are encouraging the children to be independent so please make sure all items of clothing are clearly labelled with their name.

Water Bottles and Healthy Snacks

Your child will need to bring a named water bottle to school each day. They will keep this in the water bottle area and have access to it at all times.

At school, we provide cereal, milk and fruit every day.

Lunchboxes should be named and contain healthy snacks.

There is a 'no nuts' policy in school, meaning that snacks/lunch must not contain any products containing nuts.

PPA Cover

Miss Bush has her Planning, Preparation and Assessment (PPA) time on a Thursday afternoon. During this time, Mrs Farrow will be leading learning in Year 2.

Reading Record

When you read books at home with your child, be sure to make a note of it in their 'Reading Record'. Your child will get to take home a new book to read each week. It is really important that these books are brought back to school the next week to be changed over. We only have a limited supply so your cooperation is appreciated! The Reading Records will be checked regularly by the Year 2 staff so we can support the children with their love of reading.

Home learning

The children will be given a 'Take Away Task' each term, related to our learning journey. This gives them a chance to extend and develop their creative ideas. Maths home learning, spellings and a reading comprehension sheet will be given out every Friday to support your child's learning at home. Your child will be given a spelling journal for them to use at home to practise for our weekly spelling quiz on a Friday. The children who bring in their homework will receive a raffle ticket, getting a chance at winning a prize each week!
